## Social Justice Opportunities

### **Black Lives Matter Vigil every Monday from Noon to 6pm**

Participants hold signs and bear public witness of their support for racial justice improvements in our country. The vigil starts at the Putnam Street Bridge, the corner at the Muskingum Park parking lot. After a few hours there, the participants walk down Front St. to the Fountain at the corner of Front and Greene and continue the vigil there.

30-40 cars honked their support during the time we were there. That was very uplifting, and we waved our signs back at them. So if you can't be in the vigil, that's another way you can show support for this cause. We recommend you really LEAN on the horn ... be loud and proud! We can tell you it sure boosts the spirits of those in the vigil.

**UU the Vote-** Training for phonebanking with goals to reach and register voters across the board.

Wednesday kicked-off General Assembly (GA) with a training on **Organizing Your Congregation to #UUTheVote** -- with over 800 attending! We were charged by our friends at **Democracy Initiative** and our partners at **Showing Up for Racial Justice (SURJ)** and **Puente Human Right Movement** to wage justice in the streets, in support of movement demands, and at the ballot box. We heard about ways we can combat voter suppression, protect our elections, and have values-based conversations about racial injustice as a core piece of our electoral organizing.

Friday night Elsa Schafer of **Reclaim our Vote** met with 75 of us who made 26,686 additional calls to Texas voters. She emphasized that we are calling people who do not get frequent campaign calls, who get overlooked and are ignored. I had a great experience talking with lots of people who wanted information about where and how they could vote. And Elsa pointed out that when we do get wrong numbers, we're still doing a great service because we are 'cleaning up' the list for the next round of calls.
