FUUSM Pianist, Randall Kidder will present *Music of the Sayyids and the Dervishes* [Volume Two of the Four-Volume series *Music for the Piano*]; an evening of piano music in the musical idiom of the Middle East *Sayyids and Dervishes* occupies a special place in the body of works by Armenian philosopher, composer and mystic George Ivanovitch Gurdjieff (1877-1949) and Ukrainian composer Thomas De Hartmann (1885-1956). (<u>https://www.gfnyc.org/</u>) Meditative and mindful, these compositions stem from melodies and music Gurdjieff heard in remote monasteries in Asia and the Middle East. The Dervish pieces are often characterized by powerful dance rhythms, full of spiritual fervor, while the music of the Sayyids presents more of a mystery.
