Subcommittees/Chair Situation.

Caroline reviewed the suggestions from the September meeting, with the following outcomes from committee response and discussion:

find a new chair/co-chair – Dawn Hewitt agreed to contact **Heather Royer** and discuss serving as co-chair with her through December before taking on the chair position; She reiterated the need for support from subcommittees.

rotate chairmanship, especially for chairing meetings – Having acting chairs for meetings when the chair can't be present is a good idea.

dissolve the committee – This suggestion was totally dismissed from consideration.

form a subcommittee to help organize our activities - Good idea, but no definitive action taken at this meeting.

meet quarterly instead of monthly – Discussion revolved around having full committee meet quarterly, with subcommittees or working teams meeting during months when their activities were involved. No definitive action taken at this meeting.

Calendar of Green Sanctuary activities presented by Adeline Bailey was reviewed with input from those present. A copy of the calendar with additions is included with these minutes.

Review of mission statement and goals from certification application was tabled until next

Just Dinner. The September 25 Just Dinner was discussed, and the difficulties GS experienced in reaching out to other groups in the community. The committee voted to skip the November Just Dinner, avoiding the holiday season and allowing time to form a subcommittee to organize a Just Dinner in February. (The usual date has been the third Friday of the month in the quarterly rotation, so February 19 would be the next date.) Caroline Putnam and Dawn Hewitt volunteered to be part of the subcommittee.

Low Carbon Diet Fall Group. The fall LCD group has been rolled into the Religious Explorations sessions beginning on November 22 and running through January 16. It was suggested that we consider offering another group sometime after the first of the year.

GS January 10 Worship Service. Although no official subcommittee was formed, **Dawn Hewitt** and **Rebecca Phillips** volunteered to work on the service. **Jane Tumas-Serna** has already agreed to be Worship Associate. Adeline gave Dawn Hewitt some additional information about expectations from Worship and Music about planning the service.

Gardening Classes. Roger Kalter has requested new leadership for this project that usually begins in late January or early February. Several possible organizers were suggested; Roger will contact FUUSM friend Cindy Brown and other Master Gardeners. Roger is willing to mentor new leaders and explain what's involved with getting the project rolling.

Area Environmental Group activities. A group for faith communities organized to respond to Pope Francis' recent encyclical met Wednesday, October 14. Adeline and Mike Bailey attended and will report more information as it becomes available. On Thursday, October 15, Dawn Hewitt, Rebecca Phillips and Rev. Kat Hawbaker attended an introductory meeting for a group with a more activist approach to responding to climate change: Citizens Climate Lobby. More information about a Mid-Ohio Valley chapter will be available soon.

Solar Panels project. George Banziger reported that it looks like solar panels will be added to FUUSM's proposed capital campaign, but how the purchase of the panels will be funded is still to be considered.

Interfaith Power and Light. Dawn Hewitt will check into what the Ohio IPL offers.

Marietta Recycle Center. The \$125 donation to the Recycle Center has been sent.

It's Easy Being Green *revisions*. Dawn and Adeline from the summer LCD group have taken a first look at the booklet and recognize that portions of it are outdated. More information to follow.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 1:30 p.m.
